SEND PROVISION MAP

Kingsdown is a Special school for boys with statements of Special Educational Needs or Education, Health and Care Plans. All our pupils' have emotional, social and mental health needs which present as challenging behaviour. Boys are taught in very small groups (max 4) with support and all learning is carefully differentiated to ensure it is accessible to all. Our curriculum and all of our whole school systems, procedures and policies are designed to meet the needs of pupils with social, emotional and mental health needs presenting as challenging behaviour and to comply with statutory requirements (eg meetings with parents to review progress at least 3x per annum, Annual reviews of statements & EHC Plans etc. Many pupils have a range of additional special needs and these may be met with provision which is additional to or different from the rest of the pupils. These additional provisions are illustrated in the provision map below. However as a very small school all our approaches are highly personalised and we aim to be very flexible in responding to identified and emerging needs.
